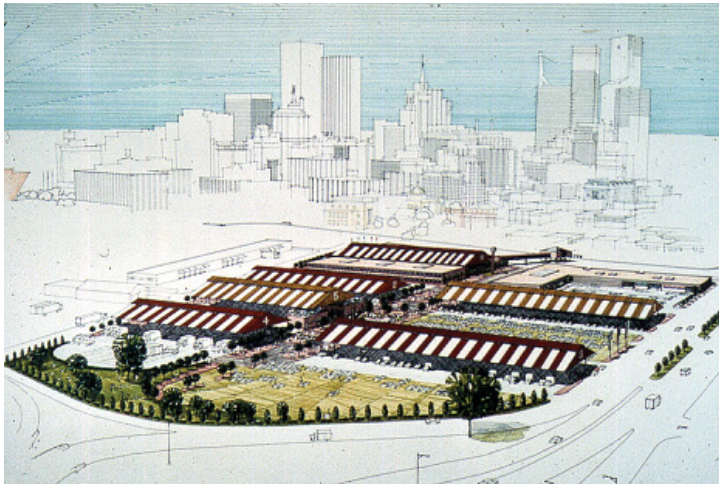


Farmers Market Master Plan

The Urban Plans Division of the City of Dallas Planning Department, as part of the bond program development process, analyzed and made recommendations for the improvements to the Farmers Market facilities in southeast downtown Dallas. As the urban planner, Gary Skotnicki prepared a master plan that undertook the effort to plan for the growth and enhancement of the facilities and grounds, dealing in large part with issues of traffic, parking, pedestrian safety, expansion and character. Based on the plan and package, bonds were designated for the master plan and expansion and enhancements occurred over time in subsequent decades.
