

Hearl Residence



ARCHITEXAS provided full architectural services to develop the master plan beginning in mid 2003, initiating the addition of a new two-story garage with guest quarters/entertainment room above, breezeway and porch connecting it to a ca. 1920 four bedroom, four bath residence, as well as redesign the front entry porch, and add a second floor library, office and master closet wing. The master plan was designed to allow the immediate construction of the garage/study/guest quarters in 2004, in an appropriate style to the main structure, with plaster walls and unique copper mission tile roof. An arts and crafts character was utilized to support the house, and create covered outdoor spaces. A limestone tuscan entry portico was added in 2005, giving the front elevations visual weight and classic lines. The final library wing over the existing den, will take place in 2006.
